TIP:

Line 4 and Line 9 - Personal Exemption Deduction and Exemption Credit

Every taxpayer who files an Ohio income tax return is entitled to a personal exemption deduction of \$1,350 (line 4) and a \$20 exemption credit (line 9). You are entitled to this deduction and credit even if you can be claimed on another taxpayer's tax return. Some taxpayers (mostly working students) are not taking advantage of this deduction/credit because they are claimed on their parents' return and mistakenly believe they are not entitled to the personal exemption deduction and exemption credit provided on the Ohio return. By taking advantage of the deduction and credit, you will increase your refund or decrease the amount you owe.
